Post-Graduation Success Found by the Class of 2019

The Class of 2019 totaled 1142 graduates for December 2018 & January/May/August 2019. The survey knowledge rate was 84.9% with information obtained on 969 graduates. Knowledge rate is defined as the percent of graduates for which the institution has reasonable & verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities. Career Preparation at UW-Green Bay

For the question "My undergraduate experience at UW-Green Bay prepared me for the next step in my career path", 81.3% of the 610 respondents selected "Agree." (36.1% chose Strongly Agree and 45.2% chose Agree.)

Position Acceptance

62.0% of respondents accepted their position prior to graduation. For those who accepted after graduation (n=277), they did so....

Less than one month after graduation	19.9 %
One to three months after graduation	36.8 %
Three to six months after graduation	26.0 %
Six to nine months after graduation	12.3 %
Nine or more months after graduation	5.1 %

Geographic Location

88% of respondents are working in Wisconsin. 24 other states were reported, with 2.4% working in Minnesota, 2.3% in Illinois & 1.6% in Michigan. 4 alumni are working internationally in Canada, Ghana, Japan and the UK.



NACE Career Readiness Competencies

The National Association of Colleges & Employers (NACE) surveys employers regarding 8 career readiness competencies which represent the attributes, skills & experiences that prepare students for transition into the work force. Employers rated the competencies on a 5-point scale.

Open by Appointment Only for Fall Semester

Individually, students will be able to shop the Career Closet for professional attire by appointment. Even with virtual interactions with employers and virtual presentations, appropriate attire remains essential. Schedule a time to shop the Career Closet through the Career Services' website, as there are specific times each weekday the Career Closet will be open. Currently enrolled UW-Green Bay students may visit the Career Closet & select/receive up to five items each semester to **KEEP**. For safety reasons, students will not be able to try on any clothing. However, any items that do not fit may be returned to Career Services. Any returned items or donations are isolated for three days. Students must present their student I.D. at time of appointment.

Career Treks Offer Virtual Industry Visits for Students

Visits for students to virtually explore state-wide employers will be offered through a collaboration of Career Services at the 13 UW System schools. Career Treks sessions will be live on **Wednesday afternoons** at 2:00pm, with recordings available for future viewing. Ideally, a Career Trek will be 30 minutes in length (<60 minutes). Career Treks will introduce students to:

1. Company Introduction: What does the organization do? What drives the organization? What makes the organizational culture interesting?
2. Opportunities: What types of positions are available to students and entry-level candidates? What majors does the organization consider? What can candidates do to make themselves stand out in the applicant pool?
3. Skills: What hard and soft skills does the organization seek?
4. What are the recruiting & interviewing processes?
5. Q & A Session for Students
6. Optional: Breakout sessions and/or virtual tour
