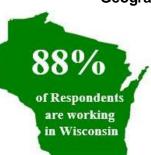

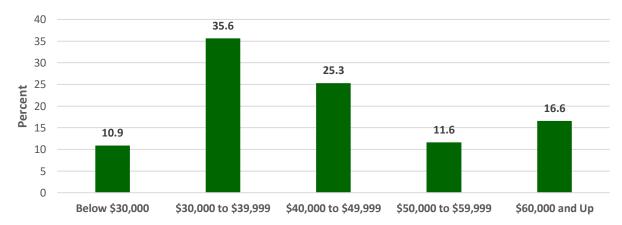
Geographic Location
