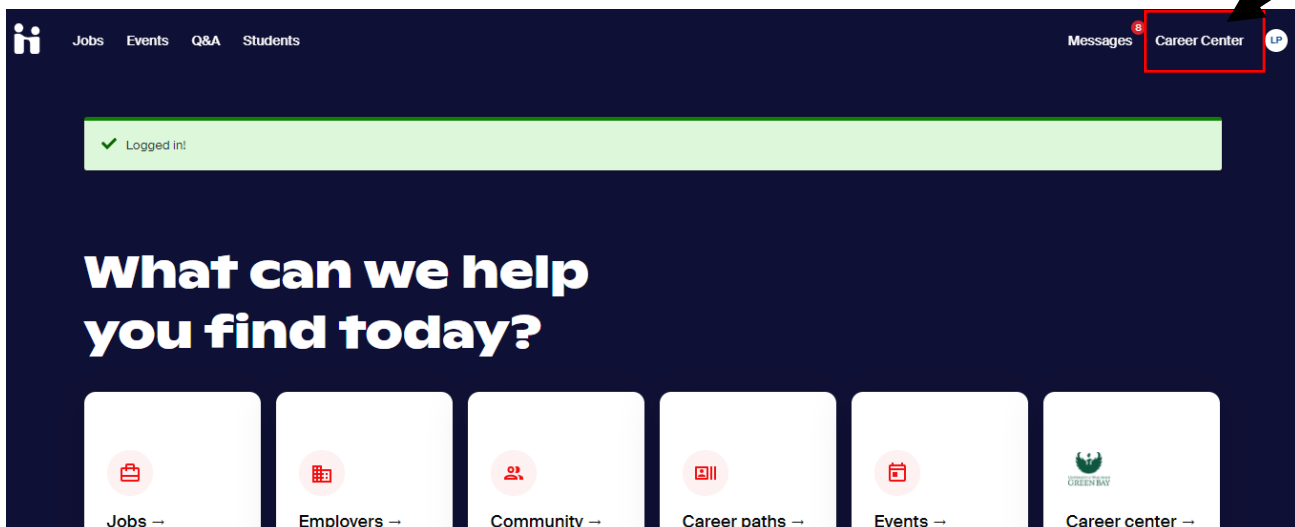


Using the Resource Library on Handshake
