

Frequently Asked Questions about Room Selection 2022-2023

How and when can I create a roommate group?

- You will need your roommate(s) student ID number(s) and beginning Thursday, March 17 you can create your roommate group online through [My Housing Page](#).

What day can I select a room?

- Year-Round students and SAIL select on Monday, March 21. Super Seniors (students with nine or more semesters) select on Tuesday, March 22. For all other students, your room selection day depends on group size. Please refer to the [Room Selection Schedule](#).

It says I can't select a room. What's the issue?

- First, check to see that you have signed a 2022-2023 housing contract. If you have, are you trying to select a room on the correct day/time for your group size and priority group? Has a friend already selected a room for you? Did you retain your room? If you still have questions, call Housing at 920-465-2040 to problem solve further.

I want to retain my room but the deadline has passed. What should I do?

- You will need to select a room during room selection beginning March 21-25. If your room is available at the time you select, you can choose your room. Note: there is no way to guarantee you will get the same room back during the room selection period.

No more spaces are available for my group size. What should I do?

- You will need to break up your roommate group into smaller groups and wait to select on the day of your new group size. Then coordinate with all new groups to find spaces near each other when possible.

How do I break up a roommate group?

- If you are the Leader of the group, you will need to select "Remove" for the individuals you no longer want to be in your group on [My Housing Page](#). Note: Removing yourself as the leader will disband the entire group for all. If you are not the Leader, you can select "Leave", which will remove you from the group.

How do I live with someone who isn't currently on campus (transfer student, freshman, etc.)?

- Using the roommate group, you can pull other contract holders into your room including freshman and transfer students as long as you have their student ID number.

My friend retained their room. How can I live with them?

- Individuals who retained their room can pull roommates into open spaces March 3 – 7 by 11:59pm. If more than one student retained their room in the same apartment, it is first come first served to pull in roommates.

My top choice isn't available. What should I do?

- Regardless if your top choice is not available, select a room and then on Friday, March 25 through March 27 at 11:59pm, you can choose the next best option. If you are not happy with your room change options, you may place yourself on the Room Change Waitlist found on [My Housing Page](#) to request a different space.

How do I find a roommate?

- You can find roommates through classes, extra curriculars or even social media. If you select into a larger apartment as a single or smaller group, then you will be assigned with other random roommate(s).

I want a different space than I selected. What should I do?

- On Friday, March 25 room changes will be available until Sunday, March 27 at 11:59pm. You can also place yourself on the Room Change Waitlist found on [My Housing Page](#) to request a different space.

I don't like any options available. Can I cancel my contract?

- You can always apply to cancel your contract, however, you should select a space regardless of your cancellation request in case you are not approved. At minimum, place yourself on the Room Change Waitlist found on [My Housing Page](#) to request a different space. Beginning Friday, March 25 room changes will be available until Sunday, March 27 at 11:59pm. You may submit a Cancel Request through [MyResLink](#) and should consult your contract for [terms of release](#). It is important to note that being released from your contract is not guaranteed.

Why can't I live in Donald Harden Hall with a Year-Round contract?

- Donald Harden Hall is not available during the summer term due to facility updates.

After Room Selection can I change to a Year-Round Contract to live here for Summer too?

- After Room selection, you will need to sign a Summer contract in addition to your Academic Year contract as Year-Round contracts are no longer available.

What happens if I do not like my random roommates?

- If it is before you move in, you can place yourself on the Room Change Waitlist found on [My Housing Page](#) to request a different space. After you move in, you will need to schedule a meeting with their Residential Education Coordinator by coming to the Front Desk, calling us at 920-465-2040 or through the Navigate App.
