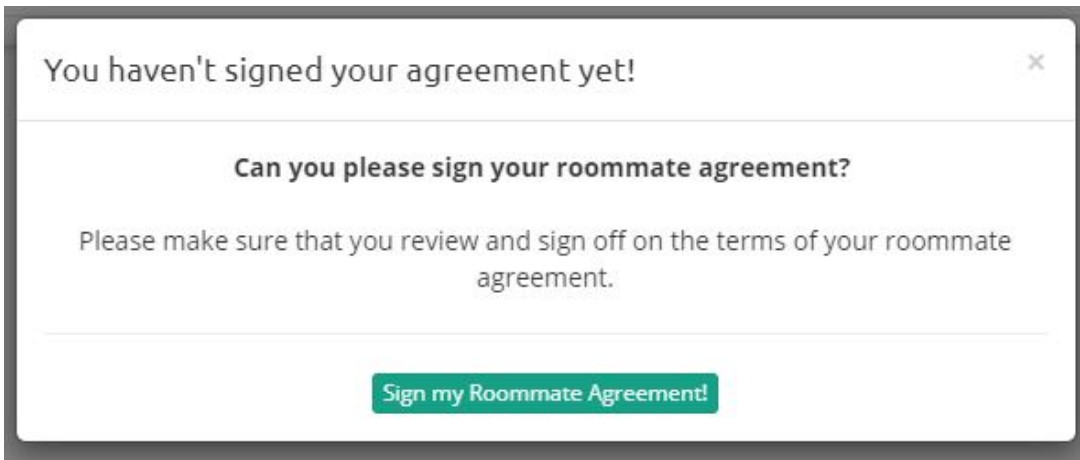


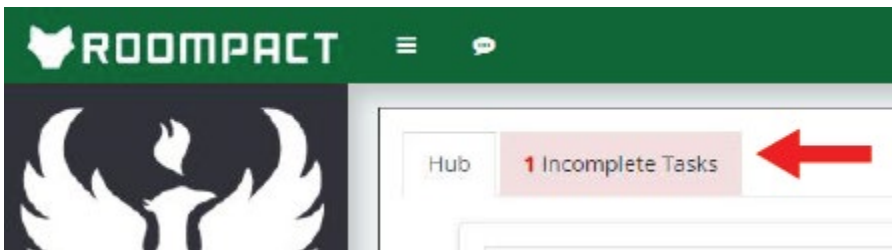
Roommate Agreement Process

The Roommate Agreement should be completed with your roommates. The Roommate Agreement process allows roommates to better understand each other and to set expectations for their living environment. Download the [Roommate Discussion Items](#) document to facilitate the discussion with your roommates.

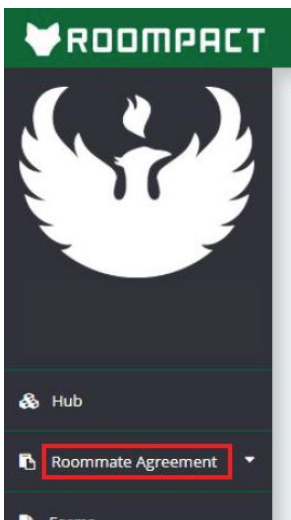
Residents must login to their [Roompact](#) account to access their roommate agreement. Residents will be reminded to complete the Roommate Agreement each time they log in. Once the resident completes the Roommate Agreement, the reminders will go away.



There will also be an indication at the top of the Roompact window.



Residents can also access the Roommate Agreement through the side menu.



The Agreement Helper (below) is the first step in the agreement completion process.

How to complete your agreement:

- 1) Finish the Agreement Helper. Incomplete
- 2) Review & modify your agreement as needed.
- 3) Sign and save your agreement. Incomplete
