Application

Your application is where our admissions team gets a real sense of who you are and your story. It's the place in which you can share who you are outside of your academics, such as work experience, extracurricular activities, skills, interests, and goals. Ask your admissions counselor about preparing your application to put your best foot forward.

Optional: ACT or SAT scores

Providing ACT or SAT scores is optional; students can be reviewed for admission to UW-Green Bay without providing test scores. Students can simply indicate that they do not intend to provide test scores while completing their online application. If a student chooses to provide ACT or SAT scores, they can be used for scholarship recipient selection, pre-requisites, major requirements and placement decisions.


