

Academic Staff Committee (ASC)

UW-Green Bay's committees are the representative body of academic staff, faculty, and university staff in shared governance. All university personnel (academic staff, faculty, and university staff) play an important role in recommending policies to the administration in many areas. Shared governance is an important responsibility. The ASC is comprised of seven eligible Academic Staff members and broadly represent the campus community.

What does the Academic Staff Committee do?

- Participate in the development of campus policies and practices, which are in the best interest of the Academic Staff at-large and consistent with the goals and mission of the University; serve as the channel for official communication from the Chancellor in regard to issues affecting the Academic Staff; and advise the Chancellor on policy and procedure changes.
- Promote the professional development of Staff members and to promote involvement of the Academic Staff in the activities of the University.
- Survey needs, review concerns, and identify goals of the Academic Staff.
- Elect the Academic Staff Representative to the UW System and ensure that UW-Green Bay Academic Staff issues are brought to the attention of other representatives, as appropriate.
- Play an ongoing and active role during all stages of the University's strategic planning and budget building process.
- Through the academic staff personnel committee, serve as a hearing body in personnel issues, including but not limited to nonrenewal, dismissal for cause, complaints, and grievances, and submit findings to the Chancellor.
