Q. When can I move into my room or apartment?

A. Move-in begins August 29, 2021.

Q. When will I receive Move-in information?

A. Move-in check-in information will be sent in mid-July to your UWGB email address.

Q. How can my roommate and I get off to a good start?

A. Contact them ahead of time to discuss interests & hobbies, as well as topics like study habits and the sharing of personal belongings.

Q. Can I bring a car?

A. You may bring a car to campus - providing that you register your license plates online and park in designated areas. A parking fee is charged to your student account.

Q. What comes with my residence hall room?

A. Each room is carpeted and includes: closet space, beds, dressers, desk chairs & desks. Each room also includes a bathroom with a shower, toilet & vanity.

Q. How do I access my residence hall room?

A. All residential facilities are locked 24/7 and are accessed with your student ID.

Q. Do I have cable TV, and Internet?

A. High-definition cable TV and wired/wireless Internet are provided in all rooms and apartments.

Q. Where can I do my laundry?

A. Washers and dryers are available in every residential facility. Laundry and vending can be used with Pass Points deposited on to your student ID.

Q. Where do my trash & recyclables go?

A. Trash and recycling containers are conveniently located near all residential facilities.





What do students usually bring to campus?

- Small lockbox
- Towels/washcloths
- Lightweight toilet tissue
- Cell phone
- Flashlight (w/extra batteries)
- Entryway and bathroom rugs/mats
- Linens for extra-long twin size bed
- 3-Prong power strip with breaker
- Computer with Wi-Fi or CAT-5E/CAT-6
- · Dishes, pots/pans, utensils
- Small Energy Star-rated microwave
- Television w/ built-in QAM tuner
- Small shovel for the trunk of car
- Games & recreational equipment
- 2-4 cubic foot Energy Star-rated refrigerator

What is NOT allowed on campus?

- Fireworks
- Illegal drugs
- Halogen lamps
- · Candles/incense/wax warmers
- Personal wireless routers
- 2-prong ungrounded extension cords
- Pets (except for non-dangerous fish)
- Aquariums larger than 29 gallons
- Open-coil cooking & heating appliances
- Personal bed bunking/lofting equipment
- Electrical appliances of excessive wattage
- Weapons (including amunition and martial arts weapons)
- Flammables (such as gasoline or propane)
- Alcohol (not allowed in residence halls)
