- How and when students apply for Financial Aid and what to do if Financial Aid isn't enough to cover all charges
- How and when students apply for scholarships
- How students add and drop classes
- How students declare a major or minor
- How students use SIS for self-service transactions
- How students get transcripts (to and from UWGB)
