Student Accessibility Services (SAS) provides academic accommodations for students with documented disabilities at all four UW - Green Bay locations.

SAS serves students with both **VISIBLE** and **INVISIBLE** disabilities:

- Psychological Disabilities/Mental Health
- Attentional Disabilities/ADHD
- Learning Disabilities
- Low Vision or Blindness
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Deaf or Hard of Hearing
- Mobility or Physical Disabilities
- Other Health Related Impairments

Students can apply for accommodations on our website. **GB Access** is the program students use to communicate with SAS and faculty. Students can easily register for services, upload their documentation, request accommodations and facilitate their accommodations. Services are individualized based on a student's need to have equal access to UW-Green Bay.

Accommodations include but are not limited to:

- Least distractive environment for testing (SAS Testing Center)
- Extra time for tests and exams
- Notetaking accommodations
- Alternative formats: i.e. E-Text (Digital Books) and E-Reader software
- Sign language interpreting and caption media
