This scholarship was created to support student learning in history. A thorough training in history contributes to the foundation of a complete education. History also leads us to a greater awareness of the richness and complexity of our heritage. This scholarship was created by Professor Heidi Sherman, whose passion and expertise lies in medieval history and archaeology. She has published widely on aspects of the material culture of medieval Russia and on the Viking-age site of Staraja Ladoga. At UW-Green Bay, she teaches courses about the Vikings, medieval history and experiential archaeology. The scholarship is open to UW-Green Bay undergraduates majoring in History.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

- A. The University shall, on a yearly basis, have the discretion to determine which student or students pursuing a course of study at the University shall receive the Historical Studies Scholarship Fund. The recipient(s) and at least one alternate shall be chosen pursuant to the following selection criteria (based on the time of application):
1. Must be admitted to the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay as a degree-seeking undergraduate student.
 2. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
 3. Student must be majoring in History.
