

## **ENV SCI 102 – Intro to Environmental Science**

## This course transfers to nearly all public and private colleges and universities, both in-state and out-of-state.

- <u>Transferology</u> is a tool used by colleges and universities that allows students to see how courses transfer between in-state, out of state, public, and private institutions.

  - o Note: Students need to create a (free) account to use Transferology
