- o Discuss your plans for the next three to five years. How do you plan to make a difference in the world?
- O Discuss how pursuing college at this time demonstrates a change of direction in your life (i.e. changing careers, after parenting, after military, etc.).

The Personal Statement, Activities document, and Essay and are to be submitted, typed, double spaced with 1 inch margins. Your name must be on each page submitted.

- 1. Be accepted/current student at the University of Wisconsin- Green Bay, Marinette Campus
  - a. Proof of enrollment must be provided by the student before scholarship funds are released.
- 2. Copy of your applicable unofficial transcript(s)-high school and/or college
- 3. Personal Statement
- 4. List of Activities/Employment
- 5. Selected Essay
- 6. If you filed for federal financial aid, submit a copy of the Student Aid Report.
- 7. Some scholarships require employment. Submit proof of employment to qualify for those scholarships.
- 8. Select 2 individuals we may contact on your behalf. We highly recommend the use of teachers/professors/faculty or staff for your references.

If any of the required materials are missing, the scholarship application file will be considered incomplete and you will not be eligible to receive a scholarship. Applications that are illegible will not be considered.

For students attending the University of Wisconsin- Green Bay, Marinette Campus, full-time status is defined as 12 credits or more; part-time is 6-11 credits. In addition to specific requirements of individual scholarships, essential qualifications include academic record, leadership qualities, school and community involvement. Other selection criteria include academic potential, motivation and written communication skills.

Scholarship application materials will be shared with members of the University of Wisconsin Marinette County Foundation Board of Directors as well as its administrative assistant and members of UWGB-Marinette Campus Faculty assisting the Foundation Board.

Recipients must be enrolled in classes for college credit at the University of Wisconsin- Green Bay, **Marinette Campus** to receive appropriate monies. If recipient is not yet registered for classes on the first day of the semester for which the award is designated, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to reassign the scholarship. If recipient does not meet the scholarship requirements once the scholarship is awarded, the award may be assigned to another student.
