



PARKING REGULATIONS: KRESS CENTER VISITOR PARKING LOT

Specific to this lot:

- Permits are enforced Monday thru Friday, from 8am to 7pm
- No permit holders in any unmarked stall
- Overnight parking is prohibited. All overnight guests must register with the Office of Residence life and if they have a vehicle, park in the Studio Arts parking lot.
- Named or Reserved Stalls are only restricted on any Athletics' Department game day, and may be used by non-permit holders on any non-event day.

Standard:

- "Visitors" for this purpose are tracked and identified as vehicles that use parking services less than 5 times per semester. Visitors may park up to five (5) different calendar days on campus for free prior to needing to purchase a parking permit.
 - (Note: If you are parking overnight, you may use 2 visits as it's per calendar day)
- Parking in marked stalls only. Parking outside or over stall marking lines, in end zones, along the curbs or borders of parking lots is prohibited.
- Individual stalls marked with a controlling sign are restricted as detailed on the signage.
- Disabled/Handicap stalls use requires a permit or it will count towards the five free visit permits. All disabled stalls campus wide are available for use by both permit and non-permit holders.
- Your license plate must be display to the travel lane of the parking area at all times. Your vehicle plate is how your parking rights are validated. All State of Wisconsin motor vehicle laws apply while on University lands, including chapters controlling the registration of vehicles and their safe operation.
- Long Term storage of vehicles is prohibited. All vehicles must be in use by members of the campus community and in an operable condition.
