The Manitowoc Noon Rotary Club is once again offering two scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year for one student each at the University of Wisconsin Green Bay-Manitowoc Campus and Lakeshore Technical College in the amount of \$1,500.00 each.

I am requesting you share this scholarship opportunity with your students. Students should submit their application materials by **April 29, 2023**. Students should e-mail their application materials directly to me at lorik@cccshows.org. This will allow the Rotary Scholarship Committee ample time to select deserving students within the time frame of the award ceremonies at local schools. The following information will be used in the selection process:

The scholarships will be granted to Manitowoc area **second year or higher** students in good standing who are, or will be, enrolled at one of the two colleges for the 2023-2024 academic year. (The Rotary scholarship is specifically awarded to sophomore level or above as scholarship help is less available to upperclassman, though just as needed.) The students should demonstrate commitment to the Rotary tenets of service, high ethical standards, and the advancement of understanding, goodwill, and peace. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required. Letters of recommendation from past or current faculty will be considered, but not required.

Each applicant must submit an application letter containing the following information:

In addition, students must include a statement of how they expect to finance their education and a brief essay describing personal adherence to the above Rotary tenets through school, extracurricular and personal activities and commitments.

Scholarships will be awarded in the student's name with the understanding that the scholarships will be refunded to the Noon Rotary Club if the recipient changes institutions or discontinues his/her education.
