The Rolfe E. White Scholarship is awarded to students who have a significant investment in strengthening their professional work on behalf of low-income people. This scholarship is available to UW Green Bay social work students who will be seniors in the coming fall semester. Applications are evaluated based on submission of materials addressing the criteria below. Applying for this scholarship requires you to complete an online application form. The form will ask for all of the information requested below; the items are replicated here so that applicants have time to reflect on their responses before submitting them. To apply, please click <u>here</u> to access the form; applications will only be accepted through the link provided. You will be asked to provide the following:

- 1) Documentation demonstrating your good academic standing in the Social Work Program.
- 2) Explain why you believe that addressing poverty issues is integral in social work practice.
- 3) Discuss approaches that you believe would be successful in reducing poverty among social work clients.
- 4) Discuss how you will work to reduce impact of poverty on clients when you find employment as a social worker after graduation.
