### When It Comes Time for Renewal

Once you become an approved Train-the-Trainer, you will need to renew your instructor status every two years, which includes obtaining continuing education hours. WCA offers online continuing education courses that can be completed at your own pace in the comfort of your own office or facility.

Trainers can choose to receive their continuing education hours in the subject they are approved in, or they can take three hours of Adult Learning Education as part of their required continuing education hours.
