This will not be seen in your time here. I am awaer of the change for the online fee and for the pution for the online classes and the fee. I agree that we are making the right case. We have been having this conversation for years for the UW system.. We are the only school in UW with the sike fee. The



online fee is unfair and its been here a long time. The problem we are having is we need to change it to a different fee. We can not use sike fees, We are trying to reduce the fee for the university students that have to take an online course. We must take it to the bored of regions, but they will not let us. This petition may of just helped us been able to take it to the bored of regions.

- Sawyer: Where is the phoenix innovation will be going.
- Chancellor Alexander : it will not touch any wildlife land. It will be in the front. It started in the middle and then built out. We are trying to keep the beauty of the campus.
