Whereas: The University has a student body population of above 10,000 enrolled students.

Whereas: The student population has continued to grow, outpacing the general trend of most other universities in the University of Wisconsin system.

Whereas: The University of Wisconsin Green Bay campus is outside the city center and detached from a significant portion of employment centers that could offer internships to students.

Whereas: The University has acquired land through a land transfer to continue developing the campus to offer new opportunities to students.

Whereas: The natural environment around the campus is a major attribute that the university is widely known for.

Whereas: Students as paying members, should have input in changes to the campus.

Therefore, be it resolved: The University of Wisconsin Green Bay should be allowed to develop the Phoenix Innovation Park on the land between the Wood Hall Dr and Main Entrance Dr.

Therefore, be it further resolved: Because of the growth of the student population at UWGB, the Phoenix Innovation Park should be built to offer more opportunities to the many new students.
