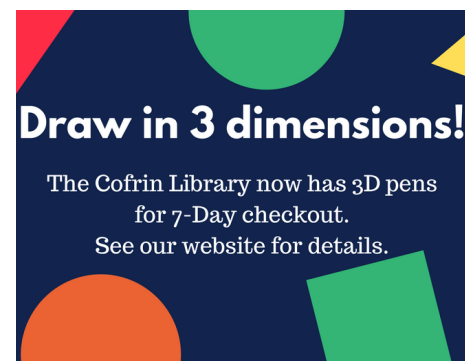
## New Noise Levels

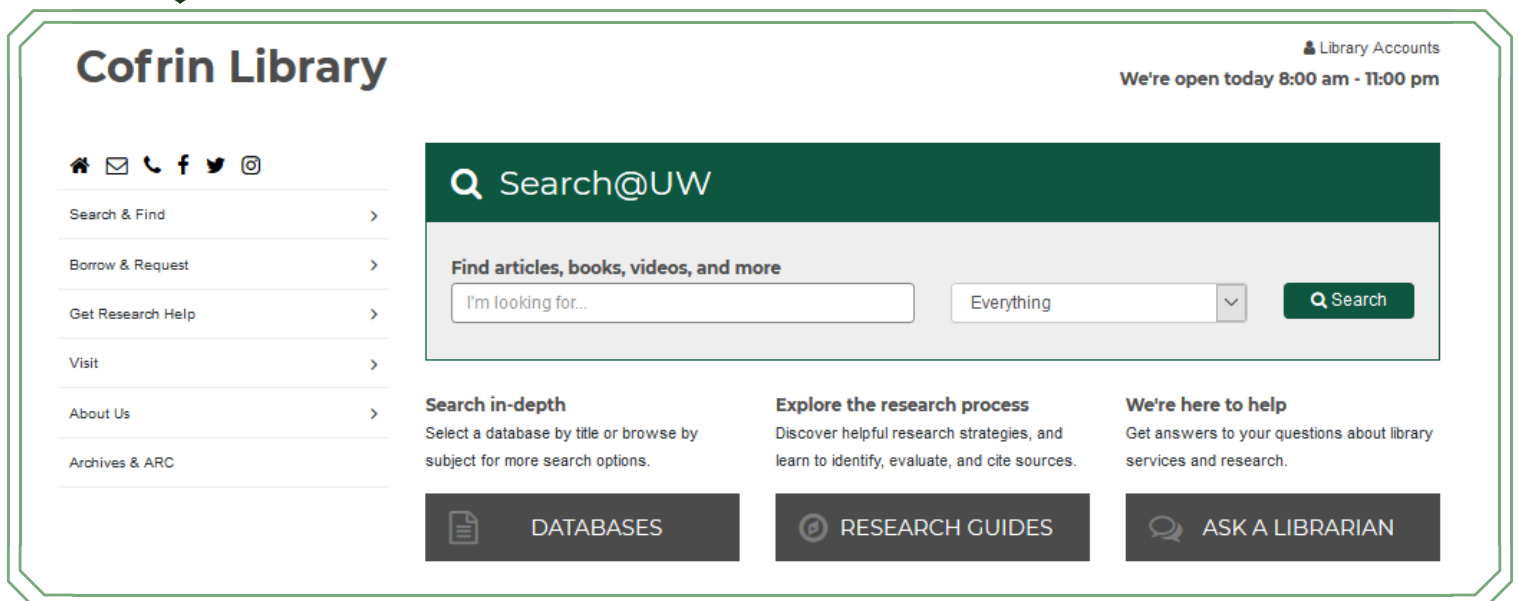
The Cofrin Library now has 3D pens for 7-Day checkout. See our website for details.

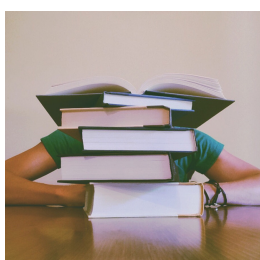
