### AT THE IN-PERSON SESSION

Students are required to sign up for this session. The sign up link is emailed to students, along with their UW-Green Bay account information. If you cannot attend the session at your campus, contact your advisor.

#### Parking Permit - Green Bay Campus only

You will enter your license plate information and pay for your parking permit or opt out of parking if you will not be parking on campus. There is time built into the session to do this as a group with ECCP staff members to assist

#### JWalk Schedule

In small groups led by ECCP staff, you will walk your schedule to familiarize yourself with campus

#### つ(Optional) Student ID

Students have the ability to get a student ID card. The cost is \$15 and is not covered by ECCP

- ECCP students do not need a student ID card for coursework or accessing campus
