ACADEMIC RITUAL AND ATTIRE

The procedure followed for awarding of degrees at most American universities is based on a practice developed at the University of Paris almost 800 years ago. In those days, the Bishop of Paris, like every other bishop, was responsible for educational matters. As the new university developed, he naturally claimed authority over curriculum and degree granting. His authority however was disputed by teachers who asserted only they could judge students' qualifications.

A threatened impasse was resolved by a compromise under which the teachers judged the merits of the students and then recommended them to the bishop for their degrees. You see a secularized version with the Vice Chancellor, as representative of the faculty, certifying the students as qualified. The Chancellor, as representative of the Regents, who have replaced the bishop as the governing authority, then authorizes the awarding of degrees.

The caps and gowns worn by graduates and faculty are based on costumes used in universities of the fourteenth and fifteenth centuries, particularly at Oxford and Cambridge in England. The academic dress has been used in the United States from colonial times and was standardized by Intercollegiate Code in 1895. The black gowns worn by the associate, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree holders differ in design and ornamentation, particularly in the sleeves. The cap is black mortarboard with the tassel worn over the left front

quadrant. Undergraduate candidates shift their tassel from right to left at the time their degrees are conferred.

Hoods symbolize the master's and doctoral degrees, with the colors representing the field of study and the awarding institution. Graduates may wear regalia in recognition of academic status and honor society memberships.

The use of Latin terms reflects the medieval origins of academic ceremony: cum laude indicates distinction; magna cum laude, great distinction; summa cum laude, highest distinction.

At UW-Green Bay, students achieve a 3.5 to 3.749 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) to graduate cum laude. Magna cum laude honors are awarded to students who achieve a cumulative average of 3.75 to 3.849. For highest honors — summa cum laude — students must average 3.85 or higher; or a 3.75 to 3.849 plus eligibility for and successful completion of an honors-in-the-major project. To qualify for honors, students must complete 48 credits in residence.

Some majors offer special distinction honors in the major. For this distinction, students must achieve a 3.5 or higher grade point average on all courses required for their major, and a 3.75 grade point in all junior-senior level major courses required, and complete an honors-in-the-major project.

GRACE HOLSCHUH

The Possibilities of Grace

For many students, the idea of becoming a doctor begins as a romantic ambition — a childhood vision that often falters somewhere between organic chemistry and human anatomy. Grace Holschuh didn't arrive at UW–Green Bay dreaming of medicine or imagining herself in a white coat. Instead, she arrived intent on doing as much as she could, as well as she could.

“I don't feel competitive with other people,” Holschuh said. “I feel competitive with myself. I'm always seeking more.”

That drive has long been paired with a willingness to work. A standout student in rural Luxemburg, Wisconsin, Holschuh thrived academically and athletically, earning a volleyball scholarship to UW–Green Bay. She arrived as a student athlete with a strong work ethic and practical goals — no grand plan, just expectations, mostly of herself.

When entering college, she planned to pursue occupational therapy while continuing to play volleyball. Athletics brought her to campus. But, in a departure from the typical narrative, academics soon took precedence — and began reshaping what she imagined might come next.

“I knew I wanted to go to graduate school,” she said. “That was always really important to me.” Holschuh made the uncommon decision to redshirt herself, stepping back from competition not because of injury, but by choice.

“It's ultimately up to the student athlete,” she said. “I knew I wanted to focus more on school and build toward graduate school.” She leaned into psychology — a major she had chosen from the outset for its flexibility, but one that quickly became much more than that.

“I absolutely fell in love with psychology,” she said. “It's given me skills I'll use in my career that maybe other students don't have as strongly.”

Holschuh emerged not simply as a high achieving student, but someone whose academic interests began to align in meaningful ways.

“Grace exemplifies the very best of UW–Green Bay,” said Alison Jane Martingano, assistant professor of psychology. “What distinguishes her is not simply the number of her achievements, impressive as they are, but the coherence of them.”

At that stage, medical school still wasn't part of her plan. “I just didn't dream that big,” she recalls. Medicine seemed like “such a difficult, long path.”

What changed came junior year. While enrolled in Human Physiology — one of the most demanding courses in the human biology curriculum — Holschuh discovered not only that she could handle the challenge, but that she was energized by it. Around the same time, professors began asking a question she hadn't yet asked herself.

"That's when medical school popped into my brain," she said. "Now I can't see myself doing anything else."

She now works three jobs tied directly to patient care and vulnerable populations: as a medical scribe in the Emergency Department at Aurora BayCare Medical Center, a behavioral health specialist in the Child and Adolescent Unit at Emplify Health Psychiatric Hospital and a youth support specialist at Brown County Shelter Care.



Her research follows the same thread: how stress affects physiological stress response. She leads an independent honors project on how stress affects physiological stress response.

Looking ahead, Holschuh plans to apply to medical school this summer, with hopes of beginning her studies in fall 2027. She hopes to practice medicine in underserved rural communities — places much like the one that shaped her.

If she could offer advice to her earlier self, it wouldn't be about working harder. That part was already covered.

"I would tell myself to talk to more people," she said. "That's where I grew the most."

The work ahead remains difficult. For Holschuh, that's precisely the point.

"I definitely like to rise to challenges."

Sachin Shivaram, CEO Wisconsin Aluminum Foundry

Sachin Shivaram is Chief Executive Officer of Wisconsin Aluminum Foundry, a century-old manufacturing company based in Manitowoc. He graduated from Harvard University, where he studied History & Literature with a focus on Afro-American Studies and received language citations in Spanish and Portuguese. He later earned a master's degree in Social and Political Sciences from the University of Cambridge and a law degree from Yale Law School.

Although his academic background was in the liberal arts, social sciences, and languages, Sachin built his career in manufacturing and business, working in the metals industry in the United States and internationally before returning to Wisconsin. He serves on the corporate boards of GrafTech International, Broadwind Inc., Lodge Cast Iron, and Vollrath Company, and is a member of the Green Bay Packers Board of Directors.

In addition to his professional work, Sachin chairs the Governor's Council on Workforce Investment and co-chairs New North, the regional economic development organization for northeast Wisconsin. He is a trustee of UW-Green Bay, volunteers on the board of the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation, and teaches business ethics at St. Norbert College.

Born and raised in Milwaukee, Sachin lives in De Pere with his wife and two sons and remains a strong believer in the value of a liberal arts education and the many paths it can open.
