Whereas, Cords are a good way to acknowledge students that are involved in an organization,

Whereas, Members in the Student Government Association (SGA) put forth a lot of effort and time into their work within the organization,

Whereas, Recognition of hard work in the SGA will help to retain Senators, Executives, Student Court Justices, Segregated University Fee Allocation Committee (SUFAC) board members, and Residence Hall and Apartment Association (RHAA) members,

- (c) Served in any of the following branches of SGA: Executive, Legislative, Judicial, SUFAC, or RHAA, or a combination of the five during their time in SGA.
