ACADEMIC RITUAL AND ATTIRE

The procedure followed for awarding of degrees at most American universities is based on a practice developed at the University of Paris almost 800 years ago. In those days, the Bishop of Paris, like every other bishop, was responsible for educational matters. As the new university developed, he naturally claimed authority over curriculum and degree granting. His authority however was disputed by teachers who asserted only they could judge students' qualifications.

A threatened impasse was resolved by a compromise under which the teachers judged the merits of the students and then recommended them to the bishop for their degrees. You see a secularized version with the Vice Chancellor, as representative of the faculty, certifying the students as qualified. The Chancellor, as representative of the Regents, who have replaced the bishop as the governing authority, then authorizes the awarding of degrees.

The caps and gowns worn by graduates and faculty are based on costumes used in universities of the fourteenth and fifteenth centuries, particularly at Oxford and Cambridge in England. The academic dress has been used in the United States from colonial times and was standardized by Intercollegiate Code in 1895. The black gowns worn by the associate, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree holders differ in design and ornamentation, particularly in the sleeves. The cap is black mortarboard with the tassel worn over the left front

quadrant. Undergraduate candidates shift their tassel from right to left at the time their degrees are conferred.

Hoods symbolize the master's and doctoral degrees, with the colors representing the field of study and the awarding institution. Graduates may wear regalia in recognition of academic status and honor society memberships.

THE MEANING OF HONORS

The use of Latin terms reflects the medieval origins of academic ceremony: cum laude indicates distinction; magna cum laude, great distinction; summa cum laude, highest distinction.

At UW-Green Bay, students achieve a 3.5 to 3.749 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) to graduate cum laude. Magna cum laude honors are awarded to students who achieve a cumulative average of 3.75 to 3.849. For highest honors — summa cum laude — students must average 3.85 or higher; or a 3.75 to 3.849 plus eligibility for and successful completion of an honors-in-the-major project. To qualify for honors, students must complete 48 credits in residence.

Some majors offer special distinction honors in the major. For this distinction, students must achieve a 3.5 or higher grade point average on all courses required for their major, and a 3.75 grade point in all junior-senior level major courses required, and complete an honors-in-the-major project.

MONICA GARCIA

A Mentor is Born

What do you want to be when you grow up? It's a common question that young people often get asked. And that answer becomes even more important as college looms on the horizon. As Monica Garcia approached college four years ago, her answer was clear and profound: to be her truest self.

As a local, first-generation college student, the UW-Green Bay, Sheboygan Campus was the perfect opportunity to 'try on her wings.' That opportunity presented itself early, and Garcia became involved with student government and discovered her calling.

"It all just took off from there," Garcia remembers. Now, four years later, "it" includes graduating with a double major in Democracy and Justice Studies and Psychology—plus minors in Social Justice and Political Science.

In the beginning, Garcia struggled to feel connected to campus. "Going to college meant a lot, being a first-generation student and knowing that I'm giving myself an opportunity my parents didn't have."

Garcia admits to feeling out of place as a first-year Phoenix but grew into her various roles. Kristi Pearson, assistant dean of students at the UW-Green Bay, Sheboygan Campus, recalls her quiet determination and remarkable transformation. "She wasn't scared to reach out or talk to faculty and staff, unlike some students who are nervous at first. She definitely wasn't," Pearson remembers. "She's passionate about students having a positive experience on campus."

Garcia worked hard to find her own voice and connect with college. "Sometimes sitting in a classroom with certain peers who may have had more to say, I questioned myself, 'am I meant to be here?'" What shifted that mindset was connecting with her professors—seeing them as both mentors and advocates. "The professors genuinely care for their students and want you to not only succeed but grow as an individual as well."

She also thinks her dual major will serve her well into the future. "I think that the Democracy and Justice Studies (DJS) major adds to the field of psychology I want to go into, which is based in community work and advocating for individuals regarding several social issues. The DJS major provides a whole new perspective to where I'm not only learning about the individual self, but also the social issues and historical contexts that shape people's lives."

Garcia excelled academically, demonstrating research prowess through projects like her podcast on LGBTQ+ discrimination in the labor market and her Honors work in Psychology. Her dedication to mentoring and creating a supportive

campus environment earned her recognition as a finalist for the UW-Green Bay First Gen awards, twice.

Garcia has also left a lasting impression not just with fellow students, but with her teachers. As Katia Levintova, UW-Green Bay professor of Political Science and Global Studies reflects, “Monica is a mentor. Not just a peer mentor, but a true lifelong mentor, who is patient, warm-hearted, inclusive and sensitive to concerns and needs of others.”

Garcia also credits “cracking the college code” by regarding her professors not just as teachers, but mentors. “I took an interest in their classes and research, and they took an interest in me.” She’s also paid that interest forward to other first-year students like her, joining New Scholars Rising, a mentoring program where upperclassmen students of color mentor first-year students who identify similarly.

And, despite the current political headwinds, Garcia remains steadfast in her commitment to diversity and inclusion. “Unfortunately, a lot of things are uncertain when it comes to certain policies, jobs and other works related to DEI. I feel that it’s important to not back down when in these roles because these roles that support and uplift individuals are the most important thing that people need at this moment.”

Garcia prepares for life beyond UWGB, grateful for the support, recognition and sense of belonging she found. She offers this bit of advice to anyone struggling with feelings that college is not meant for them: “Don’t be afraid to take on the whole college experience. Step out of your comfort zone and know that you are where you are supposed to be.” Her efforts remind us that with courage and determination, every student can find the support and encouragement to also discover their truest self.

Barb currently serves on the boards of the Transportation Development Association, the Wisconsin Business Development Finance Corporation, Wisconsin Procurement Institute, On Broadway District, Wisconsin Innovation Board and the International Economic Development Council (IEDC). Barb is a Trustee with Lakeland University, a Commissioner with the Brown County Harbor Commission, Board member of the Schreiber Institute for Women's Leadership at UW-Green Bay, mentor with the Green Bay Packers Mentor Protégé Program and Advisory Board member of African Heritage, Inc. She received the designation of the top 275 most influential leaders in Wisconsin from the BizTimes Media for both 2023 and 2024, the 'Women of Influence - Lifetime Achievement Award' from Insight on Business and Wisconsin's Titan Top 100 CEOs.
