- Meet the course deadlines. The courses are not self-paced.
- Be honest and original. Plagiarism will not be tolerated in any online course. View the <u>Plagiarism Policy</u> for UW-Green Bay.

The Do's and Don'ts for success:

- 1. Do set aside a specific time during the day for this course--the best time that fits your schedule. Use this time for preparation and for participation (reading, studying, posting messages, completing assignments, taking quizzes).
- 2. Do check in and contribute to the class several times a week. By doing this you will keep engaged, on-track, and moving steadily toward your goal!
- 3. Do remember there are people here to help you to be successful in online learning.
