On the Preservation of the Manitowoc Campus Student Study Space

Whereas: The unilateral decision is in the making to use half of the study area and two study rooms for the nonprofit Cerebral Palsy Organization without proper consultation or acceptance from the Manitowoc Campus, which was visited by members of the administration during the summer, when few students were present.

Whereas: Approximately 30-50 students use each of the study space and study rooms daily, which is more than speculated. (2022 Fall Charts 2023 Spring Charts 2025 Spring Chart)

Whereas: Alternative means to connect the Manitowoc Campus to the community exist, such as including more organizations using the gym space, hosting job fairs in the gym, Treehouse Theater program outreach, Rising Phoenix (of which there are 366 students), and other methods to improve community outreach.

Whereas: The Manitowoc Campus' students and faculty who were informed of this decision have raised serious concerns and complaints, such as loss of student resources.

Whereas: Administration removed the former library's books, staff, and resources, and are now attempting to remove student access to it as a study space.

Therefore, be it resolved: The Manitowoc Campus, Sheboygan SGA, and Green Bay SGA are overwhelmingly against the study spaces being utilized for this partnership.

Therefore, be it resolved: The administration is requested to terminate their original deal with the Cerebral Palsy Organization.

Therefore, finally be it resolved: The administration is encouraged to utilize different spaces like the gym and kitchen for the Cerebral Palsy Organization, and/or find alternative means to involve the Manitowoc Campus in its community in such a way that would not require student resources.
